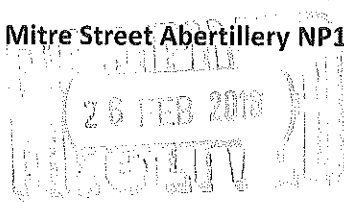

RE: Variation of Premises Licence at Berrys Bar Mitre Street Abertillery NP13 1AE



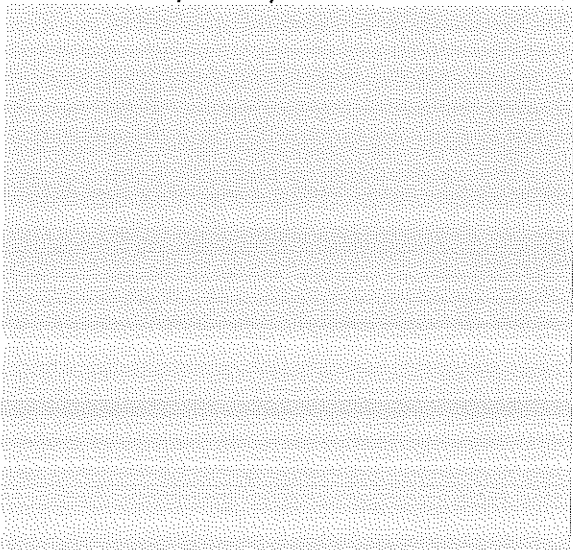
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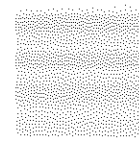
I write in objection to the variation of premises licence at Berrys Bar Mitre Street Abertillery. My main concerns are the location of the venue within the community and the noise levels that this extension would implicate.

When the bar first opened there were major issues caused locally with reference to loud music and the doors and windows were open escalating the situation. This was addressed and the premises has now kept its activity within a more acceptable level. However, I feel that by increasing its area of entertainments and alcohol supply there would be an annoyance to the people who live within the immediate community.

The premises is labelled on the exterior as a Bar and Restaurant, I feel that this extension is aiding the bar move ever closer to becoming a sports venue and function hall. As the bar is attached on one side to a domestic dwelling I am deeply concerned at the prospects of private functions being operated in the upstairs area running late into the night.

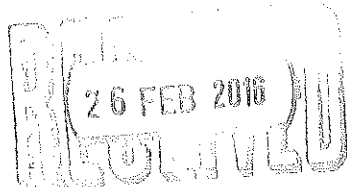




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
