Report Information Summary

1.	Purpose of Report*
1.1	To inform the sub-committee of a Temporary Event Notice received in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 in respect of Bedwelty House and Park, Morgan Street, Tredegar.
2.	Scope of the Report*
2.1	To determine the Temporary Event Notice submitted by Steven Hughes.
3.	Recommendation/s for Consideration*
3.1	<p>It is recommended that the Sub-Committee considers the Temporary Event Notice and in doing so, have regard to the representations made and the evidence heard and take one of the following actions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. To allow the event to go ahead in accordance with the notice;2. To decide that the event would undermine the licensing objectives and should not take place and issue a counter notice3. To allow the event to go ahead subject to the addition of one or more conditions imposed on the notice.

Main Report

1.	Background
1.1	To consider a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) submitted by Steven Hughes in respect of Bedwellty House and Park, Morgan Street, Tredegar in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003. A copy of this notice is attached as Appendix 1.
1.2	There is currently a Premises Licence in force in respect of the premises, issued in accordance with the Licensing Act 2003 on 1 st June 2011.
2.	Evidence and Information
2.1	The proposed event is to take place from 9.00 pm on 4th May 2018 until 3.00 am on 5 th May 2018 for the Supply of Alcohol and provision of Regulated Entertainment.
2.2	In accordance with the Licensing Act 2003, a copy of the notification was sent to the specified Responsible Authorities, i.e. Gwent Police, and Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council Environmental Health department.
2.3	Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council Environmental Health department confirmed they had no objections to the event taking place.
2.4	An objection notice was received from Gwent Police as they believe that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the TEN will undermine the licensing objective in relation to Crime and Disorder. A copy is attached as Appendix 2.
2.5	In considering this notice, the sub-committee must take account of the provisions in the Licensing Act 2003 in particular the Licensing Objectives which are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The prevention of crime and disorder• Public safety• The prevention of public nuisance• The protection of children from harm.

3.	Options for Consideration
