The prevention of public nuisance

The Pollution Team has been dealing with an ongoing noise issue in relation to the Dukestown Workingmen's Club since early May 2021, regarding loud music from the club in addition to disturbances caused by club patrons including; shouting, swearing, screaming, singing and loud voices.

A letter was initially sent to Dukestown Workingmen's Club on the 14th May 2021 making them aware that a noise complaint had been received by Blaenau Gwent Council, no correspondence was received from the club. A second letter was sent to the club on the 7th July 2021 as we were still continuing to receive complaints and a number of recordings had been received.

The Pollution Team received a message on the 12th July to ring Mr Nigel Kinsey the Secretary of Dukestown Workingmen's Club in relation to the noise complaint against the club. My colleaguerang and spoke with Mr Kinsey on the 14th July explaining the nature of the complaint against the club and the potential repercussions should the issue continue and if we received sufficient evidence, the authority would be duty bound to serve an Abatement Notice in relation to the noise issue.

As the situation had not improved and we were continuing to receive complaints and further evidence, a Noise Abatement Notice was served on Mr Nigel Kinsey the Club Secretary and Mr Ron Taylor the Club Treasurer on the 23rd August 2021 with the notice coming into force on the 25th August 2021 requiring the club the abate the said nuisance.

The situation at the Dukestown Workingmen's Club has not improved with regular reports of loud music emanating from the club in addition to ongoing disturbances caused by patrons including; shouting, swearing screaming and loud voices outside of the main club building.

Since the 25th August 2021 the club has subsequently breached the Abatement Notice on multiple occasions and those responsible at the club have failed to adequately engage with the Pollution Team and put a plan of preventative measures in place to resolve the ongoing issues. As such the Pollution Team has no other alternative than to call for a Review of the Premises Licence.

Colleagues in Licensing Team and the Police have also spoken with the club regarding noise and ASB issues however the situation has not improved.

The Pollution Team has received no further correspondence from the club since the 14th July 2021.

To date Blaenau Gwent Council has received 119 noise recordings in relation to loud music emanating from the club and disturbances caused by patrons at the Dukestown Workingmen's Club. In addition, Noise Monitoring Equipment has been installed on three separate occasions; 8-10 October, 5-7 November and 19-21 November 2021 which has recorded loud music from the club and disturbances from its patrons including; shouting, swearing, screaming, singing and loud voices.

A Noise Abatement Notice was served on the 23rd August 2021 with the notice coming into force on the 25th August 2021 requiring the club the abate the noise nuisance. Of the 119 recordings received to date 71 of those have been recorded since the Abatement Notice came into effect on the 25th August 2021.

Members of the Club have only contacted the Pollution Team, on one occasion being the 12th July 2021, the Noise Abatement Notice was served on the 23rd August 2021 and no further correspondence has been received to date.

The situation at the Club has not improved since the serving of the Noise Abatement Notice.
