3	Brief description of scheme	A laptop refresh programme ensures that laptops are regularly updated to realise the opportunities available through ever evolving technologies, to enable staff to carry out their duties to a high standard. and spread the financial burden of this investment over a more sustainable period of time All assets have a useful economic life and as such need to be replaced over time. It is accepted practice that laptops have a useful economic life of 3-5 years. A rolling laptop refreshment programme is required, as the previous major upgrade was for Windows XP to Windows 7 several years ago. In addition workplace transformation / agile working relies heavily on a fully functioning laptop estate. An assessment has been carried out of the current laptop estate and to upgrade the oldest laptops (i.e. those most at risk of failure), approx. 250 of the estimated 1,341 laptop estate, will require replacement in year 1. The remainder will need to be replaced over the following 2 years.
