- Working across boundaries with Brecon Beacons National Park Authority LNP
- LNP Cymru and Resilient Greater Gwent ENRaW projects awarded in September 2019. Liz Hancocks on LNP Cymru project board since April 2019
- LNP co-ordinator recruited in February 2020, hosted in Torfaen CBC
- Small local projects delivered including Cwmtillery Lakes LNR hedgerow
